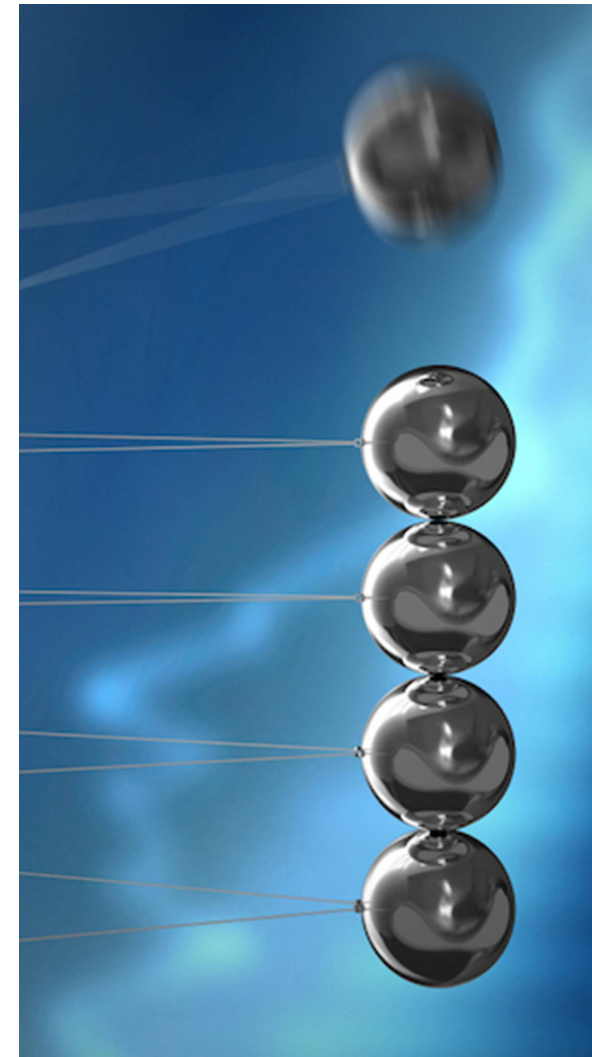

This session will address a men’s ministry mission which is done locally to serve those in need at selected locations at home and abroad. Christian Alliance, a ministry based in Pearland, Texas, solicits churches to donate their time and resources to build mobile medical clinics from 40 foot shipping containers. They then stock them with supplies and send them the world over to aide in the care of people who lack needed medical facilities. Organizing, funding, and basic construction will be covered.

Prayers that Touch God

Prayer is essential to the life of a Christian. This session will stress both a source and method that have been proven over centuries to touch God. Jesus used these; devoted monks used these; You can use them, too!

The Walk to Emmaus

Leroy Fronk - Room E221

The Walk to Emmaus is a lay lead spiritual renewal program intended to **strengthen the local church through the development of Christian disciples and leaders**. The program’s approach seriously considers the model of Christ’s servanthood and encourages Christ’s disciples to act in ways appropriate to being “a servant of all.”

The Walk to Emmaus begins with a 72-hour short course in Christianity, comprised of 15 talks by lay persons and clergy on the themes of God’s grace, disciplines of Christian discipleship, and what it means to be the Church. It is wrapped in prayer and meditation, special times of worship and daily celebration of Holy Communion.
